

# The Mayflower Compact

In ye name of God Amen. We whose names are  
underwritten, the loyall subjects of our dread soueraigne Lord  
King James, by ye grace of God, of Great Britaine, France, &  
Ireland King, defender of ye faith, &c.

having undertaken, for ye glorie of God, and advancement  
of ye Christian faith, and honour of our King & countrie, a voyage  
to plant ye first colonie in ye Northernne parts of Virginian, doe  
by these presents solemnly & mutually in ye presence of God,  
and one of another, covenant, & combine ourselves togeather into  
a Civil body politick; for our better ordering, & preservation  
of furtherance of ye ends aforesaid; and by vertue hereof to  
enacte, constitute and framre such just & equal Lawes,  
ordinances, Acts, constitutions & offices from time to time, as  
shall be thought most neede & convenient for ye generall good of  
ye colonie: unto which we promise all due submission and  
obedience. In witness whereof we have hereunder subscribed our  
names at Cap=Coll ye -11- of November, in ye year of ye  
reigne of our soueraigne Lord King James of England, France &  
Ireland ye eighteenth, and of Scotland ye fiftie fourth. Anno
